Bike the length of Japan, then tackle Iceland ... with kids?



AFTER 14 YEARS at Intel, Charles Scott needed a break. "I wanted to spend less time responding to an overwhelming flow of work and more time

creating lasting memories," he writes in his book, *Rising Son*. Charles' idea of a sabbatical? Riding a bike 2,500 miles across Japan ... with his 8-year-old son, Sho. Two years later he quit his job and was at it again, this time with Sho and his 4-year-old daughter, Saya, in tow, on a 1,500-mile trek throughout Iceland.
